### Madera County 4-H Application

#### OBJECTIVES

To recognize 4-H'ers who present their demonstration or illustrated talk a number of different times and increase their proficiency in making a public presentation.

- A demonstration is a talk in which you show how to perform an activity or skill step-by-step, explaining why each step is essential with the use of visual aids.
- An illustrated talk teaches a concept or skill that would be impractical to demonstrate in a classroom setting.

#### REQUIREMENTS

1. Review rubrics with descriptions for demonstrations and illustrated talks at [ca4h.org/resources/volunteers/councils/sectional/south\\_central/sub-sectional\\_regional\\_presentation\\_days](http://ca4h.org/resources/volunteers/councils/sectional/south_central/sub-sectional_regional_presentation_days).
2. Review 4-H Presentations "A Guide for 4-H Members" pages 4-13 in the State 4-H Presentation Manual (2005) at [ca4h.org](http://ca4h.org).
3. Give a demonstration at County and Regional Presentation Day.
4. To be followed by demonstrations given at least twice to non-4-H groups such as service clubs, classrooms, etc., AND at least two times additionally such as at a 4-H project group of 5 or more people or a 4-H club meetings.

#### APPLICATION

- Completed application must be returned to the Madera 4-H Office no later than June 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Special medals will be presented at 4-H Achievement Night in October.
