## FAQ:

Q: Who can participate in the County Events Attended and Community Service?

A: All 4-H members **including primary** who are <u>NOT</u> doing the historical star rank program! Members who are still in the historical star rank system will be eligible when they switch to the new Achievement Program.

Q: How much time can I count for contributing to a donation drive?

A: If you contribute items to a donation drive you can count 15 minutes (.25 hours) of community service. If you **plan** the donation drive you can count all hours you spend on the donation drive (planning, collecting, donating, etc).

Q: Do community service hours have to be within 4-H?

A: Any community service hours you complete in or outside 4-H can be counted. Get out there and serve your community!

Q: What counts as an event?

A: Any event that meets ONE of the following guidelines:

- Event is listed on the <u>Fresno County 4-H Master Calendar</u>
- OR is announced in the monthly county 4-H guidelines newsletter.
- OR is a state hosted 4-H event.
- OR any other County, Regional, or State level event with a 4-H specific division or participation level.

Q: Can I count community service on APR and for community service county award?

A: Yes, any community service you do as a 4-H member can count!

Q: What awards are earned by meeting the minimum events attended and/or minimum community service hours?

A: Custom medals/pins will be awarded to the members who meet the minimum requirements

Q: When are these logs due?

A: Logs are due to your club leader at the same time as the record book and project reports. A record book is NOT REQUIRED for these awards. **DO NOT** include these forms in your record book.

Q: When will awards be given?

A: Awards will be distributed by each club with the yearly service stripes and pins.

Q: If I don't get enough hours or events can I roll over to next year?

A: No, this is an annual program and events and community service hours reset each year.
